Good news: Breakfast Club will officially resume from next term. In order to book a place for your child, you will now need to book via ParentPay. **If you have not booked and paid in advance, you will be unable to attend – please do not just turn up as you will be sent away.** Please could I ask that you only use the service if you absolutely need to e.g. work commitments. This is to enable us to ensure children avoid mixing across year groups as much as possible.

Just a reminder too that any parent who requires **after-school care** can book a space with the Nursery. You can do this by calling 01303 244 055.

Unfortunately, without enough uptake on this, it will not be financially viable for the Nursery to continue offering such a service.

We will also be having some limited after-school clubs running too. Unfortunately, we are unable to provide a full range of clubs owing to the fact that we are restricted to year groups. We will continue to review this.

Next **Friday 23rd October**, we will be having a non-uniform day: children may wear their own clothes or may 'dress up' in connection with an event which takes place on 31st October. It's completely your choice but please dress sensibly (no masks)! A 50p donation towards charity is recommended.
